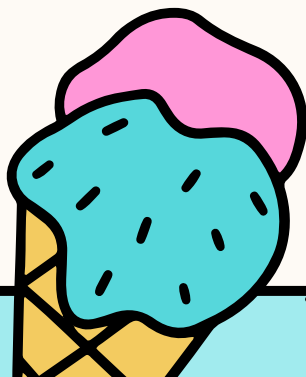
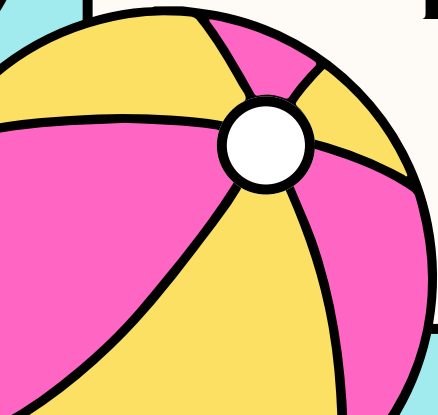
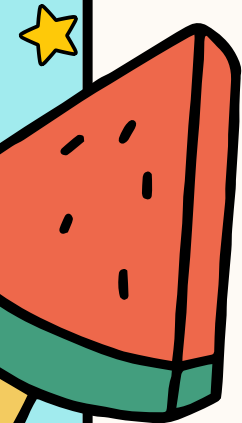

At the school, the top three contributing classes were:

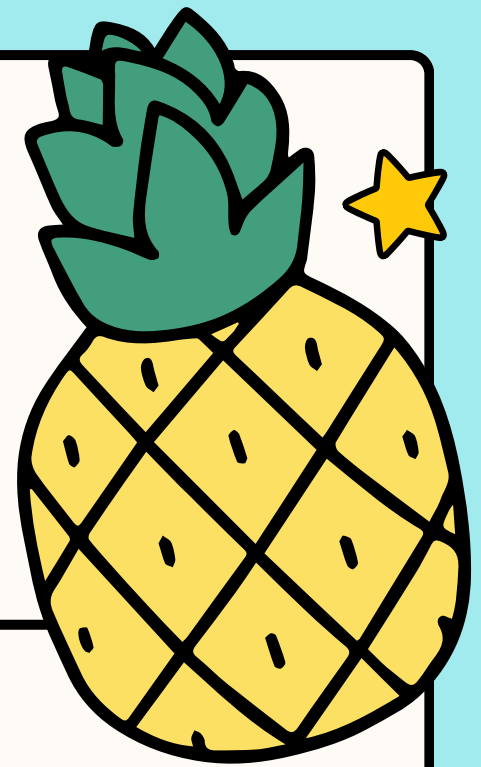

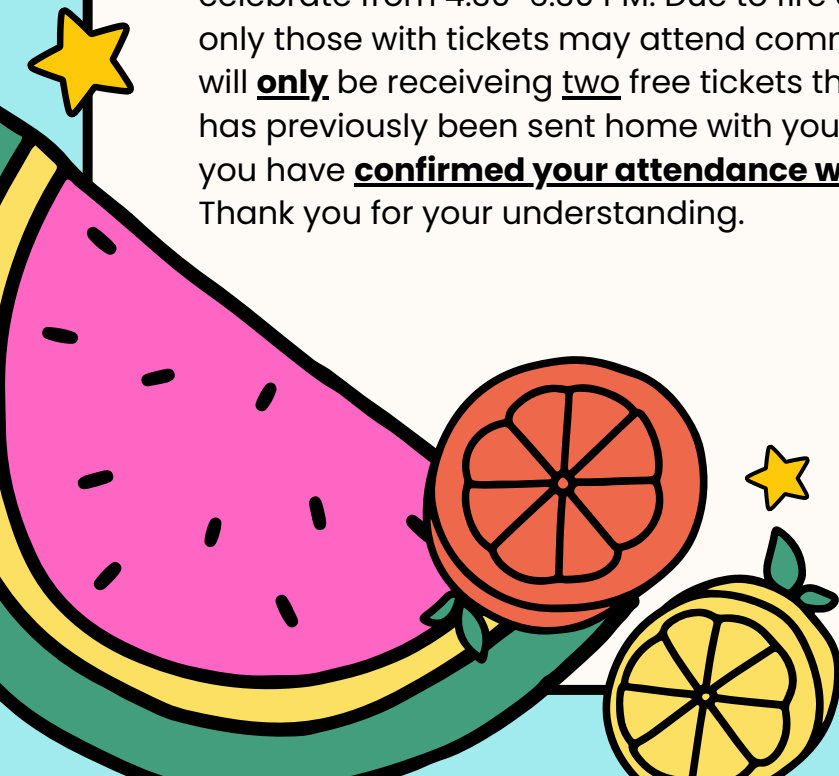
GRADE 8 COMMENCEMENT

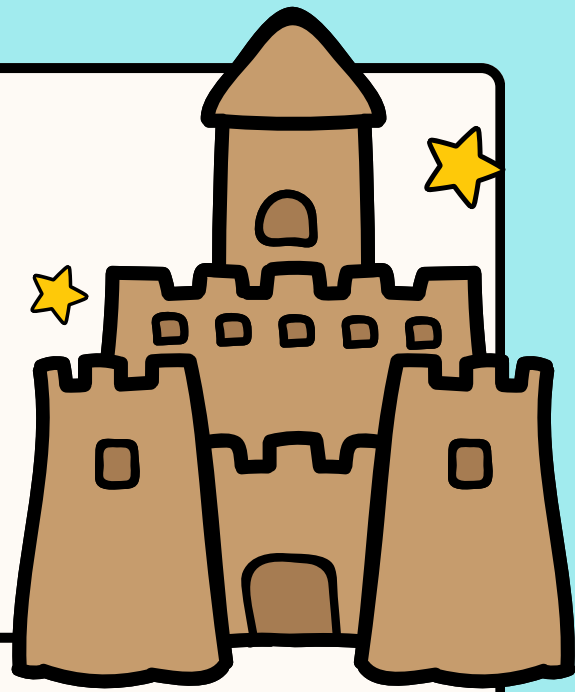
